IMPORTANT!

Florida Statute 101.043 requires photo and signature identification at the polling place. You will be asked to show photo and signature identification when you go to vote.

Accepted documents are:

- Florida driver's license.
- Florida identification card issued by the Dept. of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles.
- United States passport.
- Debit or credit card.
- Military identification.
- Student identification.
- Retirement center identification.
- Neighborhood association identification.
- Public assistance identification.

Any combination of these documents may be presented to fulfill the photo and signature requirements.

If you DO NOT have proper identification, you will be allowed to vote a provisional ballot. The Canvassing Board will determine eligibility.

Florida is a Closed Primary State: You must be registered in the Party to vote in that Party's Primary, unless all candidates for an office have the same party affiliation and the winner will have no opposition in the General Election. This is called a Universal Primary Contest and all voters regardless of party affiliation may vote in this race. All registered voters may vote in Nonpartisan Elections for School Board, Judicial Offices, Issues, and in the General Election.

THREE CHOICES FOR VOTING



Voter's Bill of Rights

Each registered voter in this state has the right to:

1. Vote and have his or her vote accurately counted.
 2. Cast a vote if he or she is in line at the official closing of the polls in that county.
 3. Ask for and receive assistance in voting.
 4. Receive up to two replacement ballots if he or she makes a mistake prior to the ballot being cast.
 5. An explanation if his or her registration or identity is in question.
 6. If his or her registration or identity is in question, cast a provisional ballot.
 7. Written instructions to use when voting, and, upon request, oral instructions in voting from elections officers.
 8. Vote free from coercion or intimidation by elections officers or any other person.
 9. Vote on a voting system that is in working condition and that will allow votes to be accurately cast.

Voter Responsibilities

Each registered voter in this state should:

1. Familiarize himself or herself with the candidates and issues.
 2. Maintain with the office of the supervisor of elections a current address.
 3. Know the location of his or her polling place and its hours of operation.
 4. Bring proper identification to the polling station.
 5. Familiarize himself or herself with the operation of the voting equipment in his or her precinct.
 6. Treat precinct workers with courtesy.
 7. Respect the privacy of other voters.
 8. Report any problems or violations of election laws to the supervisor of elections.
 9. Ask questions, if needed.
 10. Make sure that his or her completed ballot is correct before leaving the polling station.
- NOTE TO VOTER: Failure to perform any of these responsibilities does not prohibit a voter from voting.

1 BY MAIL

Want to Vote By Mail?

For your convenience, any registered voter may vote by absentee ballot. A voter, member of the voter's immediate family, or legal guardian may request an absentee ballot in person, by mail, or by telephone. One request can cover all elections through the next two regularly scheduled general elections.

Call the Elections Office at (352) 569-1540. **Requests for Absentee ballots must be made no later than 6 days prior to Election Day.** All voted absentee ballots must be in the Supervisor's Office by 7 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted.

Signature Update

Any time there is a change in your signature or identifying "mark", you must complete a new registration application & submit it to the Elections Office. If your signature on your voter record and the signature on your absentee ballot do not match, your absentee ballot will not count.

How To MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT

Our tabulation system uses an optical scanner to read your ballot.

You must completely fill in the oval for your vote to count.



Please do **not** use a check mark; do **not** mark the oval with an X; and do **not** circle the oval.

THE MARCH 15, 2016 PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY IS A CLOSED PRIMARY ELECTION.

Only voters registered with the **DEMOCRATIC** and **REPUBLICAN** parties will be eligible to participate.

Any voter who wishes to change party affiliation in regard to participation in this election must do so no later than February 16, 2016.

Absentee Information

Did you know? To request for someone else you have to be that voter's spouse, child, parent, grandparent or sibling.

Did you know? That a request for an absentee ballot to be mailed to a voter must be received by the Supervisor's office no later than 5:00 pm the Wednesday prior to the Election.

Did you know? That a voter can designate someone to pick up their ballot for them the Thursday prior to the Election.

Did you know? That your absentee ballot must be returned by 7:00 pm Election night to the Supervisor of Elections at the Bushnell office.

Did you know? For your absentee to be counted your envelope has to be signed.

Did you know? A person with a power of attorney cannot sign an absentee for a voter. The voter must sign or mark their envelope on the signature line.

Did you know? You could contact the Elections office for more information.

Update of Voter's Signature on file at the Sumter County Supervisor of Elections office

Where: Florida Voter Registration Application Forms are available at all government offices, public assistance offices, libraries and upon request by calling or e-mailing our office.
