PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY ELECTION

MARCH 15, 2016

FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE. IF YOU ARE REGISTERED AS A REPUBLICAN YOU CAN VOTE ON REPUBLICAN CANDIDATES, SCHOOL BOARD, JUDGES AND ISSUES.

IF YOU ARE REGISTERED AS A DEMOCRAT YOU CAN VOTE ON DEMOCRAT CANDIDATES, SCHOOL BOARD, JUDGES AND ISSUES.

IF YOU ARE REGISTERED IN ANY OTHER PARTY OR WITH NO PARTY AFFILIATION YOU CAN ONLY VOTE ON SCHOOL BOARD, JUDGES AND ISSUES.

EXCEPTION!!!!

UNIVERSAL PRIMARY CONTEST

EXAMPLE: IN A COUNTY COMMISSION RACE

WHEN TWO CANDIDATES HAVE THE SAME PARTY AFFILIATION AND WILL NOT HAVE ANY OPPOSITION IN THE GENERAL ELECTION - ALL REGISTERED VOTERS IN THE COUNTY MAY VOTE ON THIS RACE.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

WHEN MAILING ABSENTEE BALLOTS BACK TO THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS THERE MAY BE ADDITIONAL POSTAGE NEEDED.

NEW EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS OFFICE LOCATED ON CR 466 AT THE VILLAGES ANNEX WILL NO LONGER BE USED AS AN EARLY VOTING SITE. EARLY VOTING HAS BEEN MOVED TO THE NEW TIERRA DEL SOL RECREATION CENTER. WE HAVE ALSO OPENED AN ADDITIONAL EARLY VOTING SITE AT THE NEW ROHAN RECREATION CENTER.
