

THREE CHOICES FOR VOTING

1 BY MAIL

Want to Vote-By-Mail?

For your convenience, any registered voter may Vote-By-Mail. A voter, member of the voter's immediate family, or legal guardian may request a Vote-By-Mail ballot in person, by mail, or by telephone. One request can cover all elections through the next two regularly scheduled general elections.

Call the Elections Office at (352) 569-1540. **Requests for a mailed Vote-By-Mail ballot must be made no later than 6 days prior to Election Day.** All voted Vote-By-Mail ballots must be in the Supervisor's **Bushnell Office** by 7p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted.

Signature Update

Any time there is a change in your signature or identifying "mark", you must complete a new registration application & submit it to the Elections Office. If your signature on your voter record and the signature on your Vote-By-Mail ballot do not match, your Vote-By-Mail ballot will not count.

How To MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT

Our tabulation system uses an optical scanner to read your ballot.

You must completely fill in the oval for your vote to count.



Please do **not** use a check mark; do **not** mark the oval with an X; and do **not** circle the oval.
