PRIMARY ELECTION AUG. 24, 2010

FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE. IF YOU ARE REGISTERED AS A REPUBLICAN YOU CAN VOTE ON REPUBLICAN CANDIDATES, SCHOOL BOARD, JUDGES AND ISSUES. IF YOU ARE REGISTERED AS A DEMOCRAT YOU CAN VOTE ON DEMOCRAT CANDIDATES, SCHOOL BOARD, JUDGES AND ISSUES. IF YOU ARE REGISTERED IN ANY OTHER PARTY YOU CAN ONLY VOTE ON SCHOOL BOARD, JUDGES, ISSUES AND ANY UNIVERSAL PRIMARY CONTEST.

UNIVERSAL PRIMARY

EXAMPLE:

COUNTY COMMISSIONER

WHEN TWO CANDIDATES HAVE THE SAME PARTY AFFILIATION AND WILL NOT HAVE ANY OPPOSITION IN THE GENERAL ELECTION - ALL REGISTERED VOTERS IN THE COUNTY MAY VOTE ON THIS RACE.

SCHOOL BOARD

REPUBLICANS, DEMOCRATS AND ALL OTHER PARTIES CAN VOTE ON THIS RACE.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS - PLEASE NOTE:

WHEN MAILING ABSENTEE BALLOTS BACK TO THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS THERE MAY BE ADDITIONAL POSTAGE NEEDED. ALSO, PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU SIGN THE BACK OF YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT ENVELOPE SO IT WILL BE COUNTED. IF YOU NEED TO UPDATE YOUR SIGNATURE, CONTACT OUR OFFICE FOR INSTRUCTIONS.
