NOTICE is hereby given that the Logic and Accuracy Test of the ballot tabulating equipment to be used in the Municipal Election for the City of Wildwood will be conducted at 9:30 a.m. on November 24, 2008. There will also be a pre-test of the M-650 ballot readers on November 24, 2008 at 9:30 a.m. and again on December 2, 2008 at 3:00 p.m.

The Canvassing Board for the City of Wildwood will also convene on December 2, 2008 at 3:00 p.m. to canvass absentee ballots. Any absentee ballots will be available for public inspection from 3:00 p.m. until 3:15 p.m. The Wildwood Canvassing Board will remain in session until all absentee ballots have been canvassed through 7:00 p.m.

Provisional ballots (if any) will be canvassed on December 8th, 2008 at 9:00 a.m.

The Logic and Accuracy Tests and the canvassing of ballots will be held at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 900 North Main St., Bushnell, Florida 33513.

In accordance with the Sunshine Law of Florida, this meeting will be open to the public.

This NOTICE is in accordance with 101.5612(2), Florida Statutes.
